- Depending on knowledge and skills: work in the technical department, repairs of all kinds → **Volunteers are especially needed in the technical services!**

**Requirements:**

- Good knowledge of English; knowledge of Hebrew and Arabic is an advantage
- Willingness to work with people of all ages (especially young adults) in an international and intercultural context
- Contributing to the volunteers' community life according to one's abilities: helping to lead Sunday services, organizing community activities or outings, etc.

- Willingness to live in a small international Christian residential community for a period of at least 4 weeks or longer.
