Job description:

The village of Nes Ammim consists of approximately 75 residential units, a guesthouse with 48 rooms, and infrastructure that includes water, electricity, air conditioning, telephone, internet, and sewage systems. The Nes Ammim Technical Department is responsible for the overall maintenance and development of the village's and guesthouse's buildings, infrastructure, machinery, equipment, vehicles, and so on.

Tasks:

- Manage the technical department in collaboration with a local manager, including oversight of external contractors for major construction projects
- Lead a team of up to 5 volunteers, providing guidance and assigning tasks
- Perform daily maintenance and carry out repair work
- Plan the annual budget and ensure budget compliance
- Planning renovation and modernization measures
- Conducting problem analyses and developing solutions, including about energy conservation and renewable energy.

Requirements:

- Proven (professional) experience and in-depth knowledge in (preferably) all technical fields: electricity, maintenance of large air conditioning systems, water, wastewater, vehicle maintenance, woodworking, painting, welding, mechanics, and construction
- Good English skills (knowledge of Hebrew and Arabic is an advantage)

- Experience working with people of all ages (especially young adults)
- “Hands-on” attitude, flexible (including regarding work hours), cooperative, creative, resourceful
- Full commitment to the mission, vision, and core Christian values of Nes Ammim
