- Preparing and conducting Sunday services and performing other spiritual duties
- Developing a concept for a bilingual school and contributing to its planning and implementation, depending on personal skills and available time.

Requirements:

We are looking for someone who ideally has a background in **theology** and **education**, whose heart beats for Israel, and who preferably has experience and contacts on the ground in the country.

- Knowledge of the history of Israel and Judaism
- Experience working with people in an international and intercultural context, as well as with all age groups (especially young adults)
- An open attitude toward different backgrounds and opinions
- Ability to lead and motivate
- Strong communication skills; excellent command of English; knowledge of Hebrew and Arabic is an advantage
- Christian identity and identification with the core Christian values of Nes Ammim
- Full support for the mission and vision of Nes Ammim
- Willingness to live in a small international residential community for a period of one year or longer.
