Job description:

The Village Manager is responsible for the organization and services provided by the village to the volunteer community and to village guests. He or she serves as the primary contact for both volunteers and guests regarding life in the village.

Tasks and responsibilities:

- Developing work schedules for providing village services: cleaning of municipal village buildings and accommodations for new arrivals, laundry service (for volunteers and village guests)
- Managing and renting out accommodations; managing the village's inventory
- Budget and financial planning in close collaboration with the finance manager
- Advising the Technical Department on maintenance and renovation work to keep the buildings in good condition
- Responsible for ensuring compliance with all rules regarding pets and unwanted animals in the village
- Regular contact with the management team regarding personnel and village matters.

Requirements:

- Experience in hospitality management
- Strong communication skills; excellent command of English; knowledge of Hebrew and Arabic is an advantage
- Experience working with people in an international and intercultural context, as well as with all age groups (especially young adults)
- Full commitment to the mission, vision, and core Christian values of Nes Ammim
- Willingness to live in a small international community for a period of preferably one year or longer.
